2. Meningococcal ACWY vaccine

Adolescents 2 years of age and older
ACWY, a

- First dose: 11-12 years of age
- Second dose (booster): 16 years of age

In addition, a booster dose of ACWY is recommended for **certain groups of people**

- Adults 16 years of age and older who are at increased risk of meningococcal disease, including:
 - Adults with certain medical conditions (e.g., complement deficiencies, asplenic or hyposplenic states, HIV infection, and certain types of cancer)
 - Adults with certain types of prosthetic joints

- Military service members and their family members who are deployed to areas where meningococcal disease is common

- Adults 16 years of age and older who are in close contact with someone who has meningococcal disease

- College freshmen living in dormitories

- People who are in close contact with someone who has meningococcal disease

- Military service members and their family members who are deployed to areas where meningococcal disease is common

- People who are in close contact with someone who has meningococcal disease
